

“30 guests in 3 minutes”

Here’s a quick way to jog your memory of friends and acquaintances you could invite to attend your Norwex party. It will help you think of 30 people to invite and is easier than you think.

You might be thinking, “Why invite 30 guests? I don’t have room for 15!” Typically, only half the guests you invite will be able to attend your party, so it’s important to invite more than you anticipate. Sometimes an invited guest doesn’t attend, but perhaps she will place an outside order or book her own party. Even if she isn’t interested, she might give the invitation to someone else, which you may not have thought of inviting. Remember, no one is ever insulted by an invitation and the worst they might say is “No, thank you”.

3 Relatives

3 Friends

3 Church or social group friends

3 Co-workers

3 Spouses’ co-workers or their spouses

3 Neighbours

3 Previous home party hostesses

3 Contacts through your children (sports, teachers, dancing, Scouts, Brownies, etc.)
